A narrative is a written or spoken account of events that happened in the past, arranged in a logical order.

Every good narrative has the following:	
Purpose:	What is your narrative telling the audience about?
Events:	What are the main events in your narrative? How do they connect to each other?
Structure:	There must be a beginning, middle, and end, where events follow on from each other:
